Frederic – Leota

Frederic..... Pg# 39

Width: 50" Length: 37.5 Traffic: Some County Rds: No Forest Rds: No
ORV Trail. Mostly sandy, rolling to hilly. Couple of decent, sandy, hills on the trail. Several scenic overlooks, depending on foilage density. Narrow 50" trail. Modern staging area.

Frederic..... Pg# 39

Width: 72" Length: 10.3 Traffic: Little County Rds: No Forest Rds: No
ORV Route. Very sandy and flat. Two staging areas, modern @ County Road 612.

Geels..... Pg# 40

Width: 50" Length: 48.5 Traffic: Some County Rds: No Forest Rds: No
ORV Trail. Mostly sandy, rolling with some sleeper hills. Harder pack to the southern most portion. Some rocks. Whooped more towards staging area. Two primary loops (north/south). Several loop options on either. North loop can be wet in spots. Several scenic overlooks on both loops. Both loops are tighter 50" trail; southern portion of south loop tighter. North loop connects with Roscommon ORV Route and to St Helen ORV System via ORV Trail. Modern staging area.

Gladwin Pg# 41

Width: 50" Length: 21.9 Traffic: A Lot County Rds: No Forest Rds: No
ORV Trail. Very sandy and whooped. High use trail due to proximity to population centers. Can be very wet in spots. Connects with small Use Area at southwestern portion of trail allowing cross country trail including small sand bowl. Short ORV Route provides additional loop at north end of trail. Modern staging area.

Grand Traverse Pg# 42

Width: 40" Length: 67.9 Traffic: Little County Rds: No Forest Rds: No
ORV Trail, motorcycle-only. Generally rolling trails, some sand and some whoops. Trail #4 is the tightest, trails 1-3 are wider 40" trails. Multiple loop options. Uses MCCCT to connect between trails #3 and #4 which requires SOS license. Two staging areas.

Grand Traverse Pg# 42

Width: 72" Length: 4.3 Traffic: Little County Rds: No Forest Rds: No
ORV Route. Very short ORV Route segments within ORV Trail #4. Generally hard packed, straight and wooded.

Hancock..... Pg# 43

Width: 72" Length: 13.4 Traffic: Little County Rds: Yes Forest Rds: Yes
ORV Route. Some hills, generally rocky. Starts under bridge in town and appears to use sidewalk for some portions. Located in Houghton county which allows ORVs on county roads; some forest roads open.

Haywire Pg# 44-46

Width: 50" Length: 32 Traffic: Little County Rds: Yes Forest Rds: Some
ORV Trail. Uses old Railroad grade. Lots of interesting scenery, some wet spots. Located on USFS land in Alger & Schoolcraft counties which allows ORVs to use county roads. Some forest roads open.

Holton..... Pg# 47

Width: 40" Length: 25.4 Traffic: Little County Rds: No Forest Rds: No
ORV Trail. Open to motorcycles only, some sections require SOS license. Generally flat, wooded trail, tighter and whooped in areas. Located on USFS land. Staging area.

Horseshoe Pg# 48

Width: 40" Length: 24.3 Traffic: Little County Rds: No Forest Rds: No
ORV Trail. Open to motorcycles only, some sections require SOS license. Generally flat, wooded trail, whooped in areas, tighter and smooth in others. Located on USFS land. Modern staging area.

Hunt Creek Pg# 68

Width: 40" Length: 31.2 Traffic: Some County Rds: Some Forest Rds: No
ORV Trail, motorcycle-only. Mostly sandy, rolling to hilly. Some hardpacked areas. Lots of rocks, roots, short hills and ruts. Connects to Mio ORV Trail. Located in Oscoda and Montmorency counties; Montmorency allows ORVs on county roads.

Huron Trail..... Pg# 49-51

Width: 50" Length: 45.3 Traffic: More County Rds: Some Forest Rds: No
ORV Trail. Very sandy, usually whooped. Mostly open and wide trail in generally wooded terrain. Connects to food/fuel at Loud Dam. Modern staging areas. Located in Iosco county which has some county roads open to ORVs (see local ordinance for details).

Indian River Pg# 89

Width: 72" Length: 21.5 Traffic: Some County Rds: Yes Forest Rds: No
ORV Route, shares snowmobile trail. Generally flat and very sandy with fair number of curves. Located in Cheboygan County which allows ORVs on county roads.

Iron River Pg# 52-56

Width: 72" Length: 65.7 Traffic: Little County Rds: Yes Forest Rds: Yes
ORV Route. Uses old Railroad grade. Generally flat and rocky. Located in Gogebic and Iron counties which allow ORVs on county roads; forest roads generally open.

Kalkaska Pg# 57-58

Width: 50" Length: 81 Traffic: Some County Rds: No Forest Rds: No
ORV Trail. Mostly sandy, rolling to hilly. Whooped in sections. Tighter 50" trail. Several loop options. Connects to Pickeral Lake State Forest Campground via MCCCT. Connects to food/fuel on M-72 and Starvation Lake. Two staging areas, modern on M-72.

Kalkaska Pg# 57-58

Width: 72" Length: 33.8 Traffic: Some County Rds: No Forest Rds: No
ORV Route. Mostly sandy, rolling to hilly. Several loop options. Some isolated/segmented sections as well. See Kalkaska trail for food/fuel info.

Kinross Pg# 59

Width: 40" Length: 28.7 Traffic: Little County Rds: Yes Forest Rds: Yes
ORV Trail, motorcycle-only. Tighter trail, mostly wooded, flat to rolling terrain with sandy and hard-packed interspersed. Several loop options. Modern staging area. Located in Chippewa county which allows ORVs on county roads; forest roads generally open.

Leetsville..... Pg# 60

Width: 50" Length: 24 Traffic: Some County Rds: No Forest Rds: No
ORV Trail. Mostly sandy, usually whooped. Generally flat with mixed open/wooded. Modern staging area.

Leota Pg# 61

Width: 50" Length: 55.4 Traffic: More County Rds: No Forest Rds: No
ORV Trail. Generally sandy with rocks and hills towards the north. Usually whooped near staging area. Many loop options. Connects to Denton ORV Trail. Modern staging area.
