Width: 50" Length: 36.7 Traffic: Some County Rds: No Forest Rds: No
 ORV Trail. Mostly sandy and flat to rolling. Many whooped sections. Several loop options. Connects to Beaver Creek ORV Trail and North Missaukee ORV Trail (requires SOS for portions of MCCCT). Modern staging area.

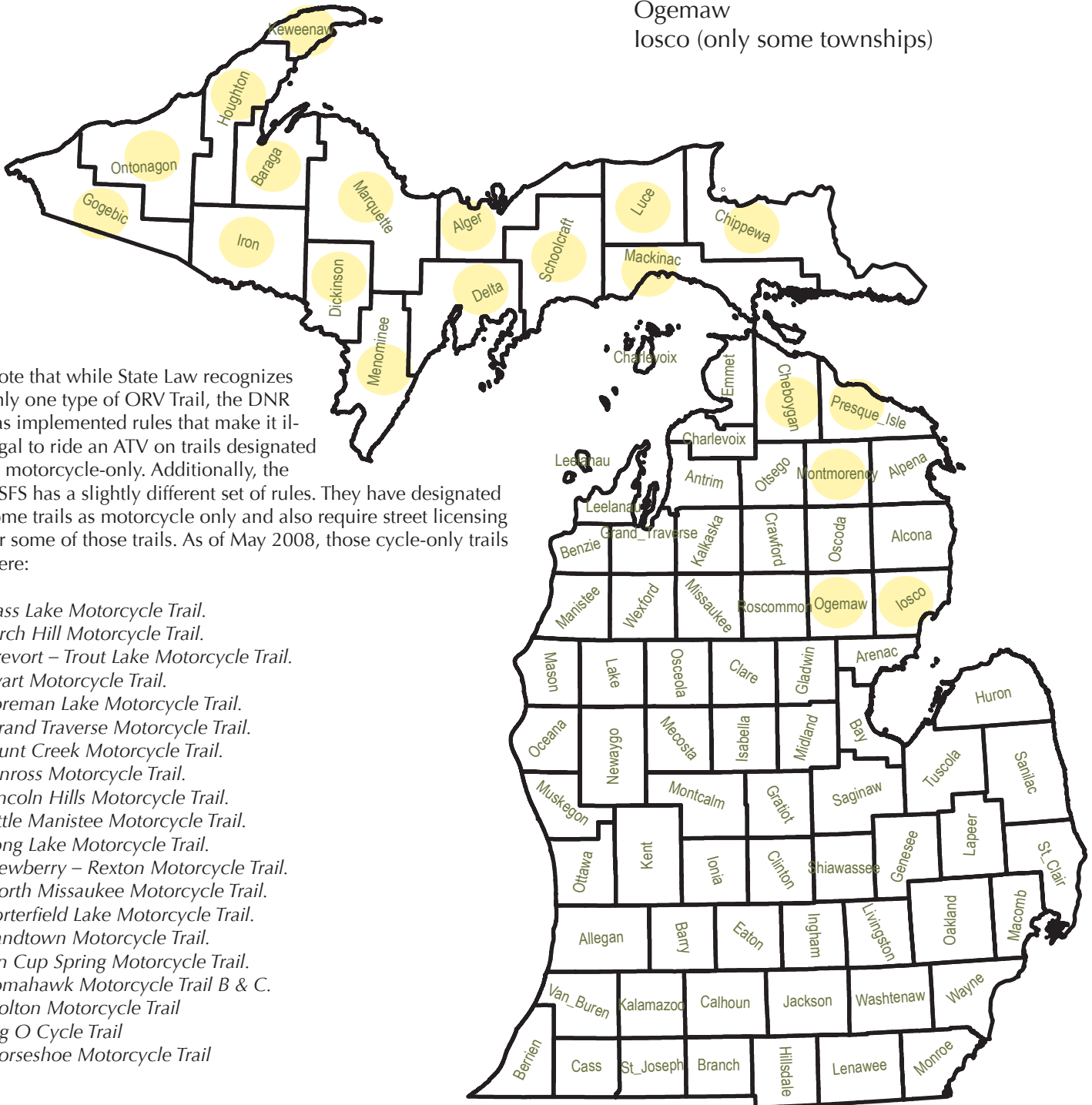
White Cloud..... Pg# 94

Width: 50" Length: 15.7 Traffic: Some County Rds: No Forest Rds: No
 ORV Trail. Mostly sandy, wider and whooped. Original section of ORV trail in State from the late 60's. MCCCT connects to Big O system (requires SOS license). Modern staging area.

Counties that currently have an ordinance in place to allow ORV use on county roads:

Note that while State Law recognizes only one type of ORV Trail, the DNR has implemented rules that make it illegal to ride an ATV on trails designated as motorcycle-only. Additionally, the USFS has a slightly different set of rules. They have designated some trails as motorcycle only and also require street licensing for some of those trails. As of May 2008, those cycle-only trails were:
